5. <u>Resolution</u> (also called <u>Conclusion)</u>= -sequence of events in a story


-characters, setting, exposes the main problem or conflict

-middle of the story where you build suspense

-the turning point- the character changes or has to make a choice about the conflict

-tension decreases as a new solution is reached

-the conflict is resolved (it's not always happy, but it's over)
